



- The God of Peace
- Peace on earth good will to men the birth of Jesus

Luke 2:13-14 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

• Reconcile man to God

2 Cor. 5:18-21 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

- God is no longer holding sin against mankind any longer
- God is at peace with you

The Devil still comes against man today as he did with Job

Job 1:9-11 Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought? Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side?

thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land. But put forth thine hand now, and touch all that he hath, and he will curse thee to thy face.

- You are saved in the soulish realm
- We are a triune being spirit, soul, and body.

John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

• Christians by large are body conscious

James 1:21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

James 1:21-25 AMP So get rid of all uncleanness and all that remains of wickedness, and with a humble spirit receive the word [of God] which is implanted [actually rooted in your heart], which is able to save your souls. But prove yourselves doers of the word [actively and continually obeying God's precepts], and not merely listeners [who hear the word but fail to internalize its meaning], deluding yourselves [by unsound reasoning contrary to the truth]. For if anyone only listens to the word without obeying it, he is like a man who looks very carefully at his natural face in a mirror; for once he has looked at himself and gone away, he immediately forgets what he looked like. But he who looks carefully into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and faithfully abides by it, not having become a [careless] listener who forgets but an active doer [who obeys], he will be blessed and favored by God in what he does [in his life of obedience].

- Until your soul gets saved, you will live in defeat
- For your soul to be saved, you must continue in God's Word

John 8:30-32 As he spake these words, many believed on him. Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

- The realm of the soul is set free with the truth of God's Word
- What is the false image casted in your mind of your own making?
- Have you looked into the wrong mirror for so long?

1 Cor. 6:12 ESV "All things are lawful for me," but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful for me," but I will not be dominated by anything.

- Choose to look into the mirror of God's Word instead
- Some of man's social involvement helps you manage your mirror

• How do you continue in the mirror of God's Word?

Choose to give yourself wholly to the Word of God

1 Thess. 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- You must deal with your own thought life
- What are you persuaded in what will govern your life?
- You do not want to be destroyed in your persuasion
- You must give yourself wholly in the Word of God
- Do not be trapped any longer
- the area that you are bound in, then you are not persuaded in God's Word in that area of your life
- Do not walk in the same trap that your ancestors or family past did
- Do not deceive yourself It is your responsibility of your thought life

James 1:22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

1 John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

Walk continually in the perfect Law of liberty of Gods Word to continually be liberated.

Spotless

2 Pet. 3:13-14 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness. Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.

• As a man thinketh

Prov. 23:7 For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart is not with thee.

• A partaker of the divine nature of God

2 Pet. 1:2-4 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and

godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

- Beloved as a son of God
- An imitator of the father as dear children

Eph. 5:1 ESV Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children.

• The Holy Spirit as a deposit

Eph. 1:14 EXB That Holy Spirit is the guarantee [down payment; deposit] that we will receive what God promised for his people [of our inheritance] until God gives full freedom to those who are his [or we acquire possession of it; the redemption of the possession; to bring praise to God's glory.

- A mind or a soul that is saved.
- One who keeps his mind stayed on thee

Is. 26:3 Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

2 Cor. 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

2 Cor. 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

2 Cor. 10:3-5 AMP For though we walk in the flesh [as mortal men], we are not carrying on our [spiritual] warfare according to the flesh and using the weapons of man. The weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood]. Our weapons are divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. We are destroying sophisticated arguments and every exalted and proud thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought and purpose captive to the obedience of Christ.

- A "stronghold" is something stronger than you are
- The Word is the first choice not the emergency default exception (Matt. 6:33)
- Bring "every thought" into captivity "to the obedience of Christ"

2 Cor. 10:4-5 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth

itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.

- Jesus' obedience set you free live in His obedience
- Subject everything (mind) unto Jesus Christ

2 Cor. 10:5-6 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

- You must give yourself wholly in the Word of God
- The deception = The lie that God cannot prosper me
- God made the universe and measures the universe in the palm of His hand

Is. 40:12 GW Who has measured the water of the sea with the palm of his hand or measured the sky with the length of his hand? Who has held the dust of the earth in a bushel basket or weighed the mountains on a scale and the hills on a balance?

• Do not base your thought life based on "your obedience" or religiosity

2 Cor. 10:4-6 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

• The truth of God's Word makes me free

John 8:30-32 As he spake these words, many believed on him. Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

- Fast for the right reason or the right motive
- Do not grow weary in religious service because of your wrong thinking in your heart

Gal. 6:9 ESV And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.

- The lie of Christianity is what you feel like...
- Take control of your thought life based on the Word of God

• You believe by measure - fully persuaded

Rom. 4:21-23 And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness. Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him.

- You will do what you believe
- Change your picture of God in context of God's Word of what you believe
- Speak the Word only

Matt. 8:6-8 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented. And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him. The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

- Resist the attack of the enemy, do not sit passively by it is up to you to resist
- It is up to you, to take every thought captive
- A prisoner of war camp, get out of there with your mouth
- Feed on the Word of God by listening to preaching on the Word of God (listen)

Rom. 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

- The Word of God is your primary source and to hear it audibly
- Be persuaded in the subjects you are weak in. Listen to solid faith-based teaching
- Establish your heart in God's Word and speak aloud to the lie with the Word of God
- Resist the attack of the enemy, do not sit passively by it is up to you to resist
- I dwell in the secret place. Speak it aloud

Ps. 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

Ps. 91:2 I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. **Ps. 91:3** Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

Ps. 91:4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.

Ps. 91:5 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

Ps. 91:6 Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

Ps. 91:7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.

- Have you given yourself over to other things other than the Word of God?

Luke 6:45 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.

- do not stay bound, take authority by taking action to get the Word of God to reign active in your mind and so in life.
- Out of the mouth of two or three witnesses

2 Cor. 13:1 This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established.



Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

• The deposit of the Holy Spirit inside of you

Eph. 1:12-14 NIV in order that we, who were the first to put our hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession - to the praise of his glory.

• Jesus is your Comfort and will Guide you into all Truth

John 16:13-14 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew *it* unto you

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

2 Cor. 1:2-3 Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort.
