





Possession with intent to distribute

Mark Hankins has a police officer in his church that took them on Patrol the show the drug trafficking areas. When he made a drug bust, he caught two individuals with enough crack cocaine in a bottle not just for their own use but to show that they are distributors. They had been charged with possession with intent to distribute.

Therefore, I am guilty as charged because I have been caught red-handed with the intent to distribute the blood of Jesus Christ because it has been applied to every area of my life. When you have possession with the intent to distribute, you ought to say I'm guilty. I've been caught with so much faith in the blood of Jesus that I was planning on distributing. I was planning on winning souls and telling people about Jesus so that, through faith in the blood of Jesus they could be launched out of the atmosphere of sin and death into the presence of God. We were redeemed not with silver and gold, but with the precious blood of Jesus as a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:18-19).

1 Pet. 1:18-19 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, *as* silver and gold, from your vain conversation *received* by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

- Redeemed = Jesus purchased our freedom with His own blood.
- We are valuable in God's eyes in view of the blood

The Righteousness of God Through Faith

Rom. 3:21 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets;

Rom. 3:22 Even the righteousness of God *which is* by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

Rom. 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Rom. 3:24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

• Justified = in God's eyes we are as if we had never sinner because of the blood of His Dear Son.

Rom. 3:25 Whom God hath set forth *to be* a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

Rom. 3:26 To declare, *I say*, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

Rom. 3:27 Where *is* boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith.

Rom. 3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.

Rom. 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

Rom. 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us? **Rom. 8:32** He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

Rom. 8:33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? *It is* God that justifieth. **Rom. 8:34** Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

• Faith is the chief occupation of the believer

2 Cor. **5:7** (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

1 Tim. 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

• Believing = attitude of faith and brings boldness

Heb. 10:19-20 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

• If you are silent you will lose by default

• I believe therefore I speak

2 Cor. **4:13** We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;

• Give thanks for the blood – you have been qualified

Col. 1:12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

• Stand up right on your feet I have washed you in my blood and made you worthy (Jesus)

Eph. 2:6 And hath raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus:

Col. 1:13 Who **hath delivered us** from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son:

Eph. 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

Eph. 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Eph. 1:19 And what *is* the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,

Eph. 1:20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set *him* at his own right hand in the heavenly *places*,

• Includes the remission of sin (guilt and shame)

Col. 1:14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

- <u>The Chicken Story:</u>
- Chicken legs tied / bound so long
- Chickens released and string cut loose
- Slap the chickens run loose (believer)
- Jesus has redeemed you in His blood enjoy your freedom in Christ
- Jesus purchased our freedom once and for all

Heb. 9:12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption *for us*.

Heb. 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

Heb. 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, **purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?**

Heb. 10:1 For the law having a shadow of good things to come, *and* not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.

Heb. 10:1 ISV For the Law, being only a reflection of the blessings to come and not their substance, can never make perfect those who come near by the same sacrifices repeatedly offered year after year.

Heb. 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Heb. 10:2 For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins.

Heb. 10:3 But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year.

Heb. 10:4 For *it is* not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

Heb. 10:5 Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me:

Heb. 10:6 In burnt offerings and *sacrifices* for sin thou hast had no pleasure.

Heb. 10:7 Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God.

Heb. 10:8 Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and *offering* for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure *therein;* which are offered by the law;

Heb. 10:9 Then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second.

Heb. 10:10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for all*.

Heb 10:11 And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

Heb 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;

Heb 10:13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.

Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

Heb 10:14 NET For by one offering he has perfected for all time those who are made holy.

Heb. 10:15 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,

Heb. 10:16 This *is* the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

Heb. 10:17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.

- The Blood of Jesus has the power to remove to our sin from the mind of God
- The Blood of Jesus has the power to remove your sin conscience and the remembrance of sin
- He replaced your sin consciousness and replaced it with righteousness consciousness.

Christ's Sacrifice Once for All

The blood of animals can never take away the guilt for sins

Heb.10:1-10 Barclay Because the law is only a pale shadow of the blessings which are to come and not a real image of these things, it can never really fit for the fellowship of God those who seek to draw near to his presence with the sacrifices which have to be brought year by year and which go on forever. For if these sacrifices could achieve that, would they not have stopped being brought because the worshipper had been once and for all brought into a state of purity and no longer had any consciousness of sin?

Heb.10:1-10 WNT For, since the Law exhibits only an outline of the blessings to come and not a perfect representation of the things themselves, the priests can never, by repeating the same sacrifices which they continually offer year after year, give complete freedom from sin to those who draw near. For then would not the sacrifices have ceased to be offered, because the consciences of the worshippers--who in that case would now have been cleansed once for all--would no longer be burdened with sins?

Heb. 10:1-2 TNT Just like a shadow vaguely represents the thing that it is a shadow of the laws that God *gave Moses* only poorly represent the good things that were to come later. Those laws were not all the good things themselves that God has promised. So, by offering the same kinds of sacrifices every year, people who approach God can never become perfect/all that God intends them to be. If God had removed the guilt for having sinned of those who brought the sacrifices, they would not feel that they were still guilty. So, they would certainly have stopped offering those sacrifices!

Heb. 10:2 Doddridge Let us not stand at a distance as if God were inaccessible; but on the contrary, let us draw near with a sincere and affectionate heart, in the full assurance of faith, supported by such considerations as these, which may well embolden us...to make our approach unto Him in the most cheerful expectation of His blessing.

• Psychiatrists say that if we could get rid of guilt and shame, it would eliminate 80% of the mental cases

Is. 54:14 In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee.

The animal park and the Lama Story

- Lama sneeze no evidence after cleaning but a little bit of smell = guilt and shame
- The Blood of Jesus has the power to remove the stain and the smell of sin
- By the blood of Jesus, I have made been made perfectly righteous no sense of inferiority
- Sling blood everywhere
- Free from a sense of lack or shame
- Don't stay another day depressed you are restored
- Expect God's best blessings

Heb. 10:17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.

Heb. 10:18 Now where remission of these *is*, *there is* no more offering for sin.

The Full Assurance of Faith (Boldness)

Heb. 10:19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, **Heb. 10:20** By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is

to say, his flesh;

Heb. 10:21 And *having* an high priest over the house of God;

Heb. 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Heb. 10:23 Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;)

Jesus the Great High Priest

Heb 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, **let us hold fast** *our* **profession**.

Heb 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as *we are, yet* without sin.

• Our move as believers to come boldly to the Father God

Heb 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

• By the blood of Jesus mercy is extended to you

Ps. 16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence *is* fulness of joy; at thy right hand *there are* pleasures for evermore.

Ps. 100:5 For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

Lam. 3:22-23 *It is of* the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. *They are* new every morning: great *is* thy faithfulness.

Heb. 10:22 Lovett Let us as members of His family, exercise our right of access and press closer and closer to the Father. But we must come with childlike faith and the unshakable assurance that He is eager to receive us.

James 4:8 NLT Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world.

Zec. 3:7 "Thus says the LORD of hosts: If you will walk in my ways and keep my charge, then you shall rule my house and have charge of my courts, and **I will give you the right of access** among those who are standing here.

- We must exercise our right of access into the throne room
- We come with a childlike faith and that the Father is eager to receive us
- The Getting' Place

Ps. 91:1 He that dwelleth in **the secret place of the most High** shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

Ps. 91:2 I will say of the LORD, *He is* my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.

Ps. 31:19 *Oh* how great *is* thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; *which* thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!

Ps. 31:20 Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.



<u>Rev. 5:9</u> And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

• Jesus is the go-between

1 Tim. 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

• Your active part – align your heart with your mouth

Rom. 10:9-10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

• Made righteous

2 Cor. 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Revelation – if over 80% of the world is not blood conscience – counting the blood of Jesus Holy and precious...

1 Thess. 5:16-23 Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. Abstain from all appearance of evil. And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Heb. 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

• Jesus is God's Gift for you

Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

• In Him

Acts 17:27-28 ESV that they should seek God, and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him. Yet he is actually not far from each one of us, for 'In him we live and move and have our being'; as even some of your own poets have said, 'For we are indeed his offspring.'

Communion:

John 6:47-58 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. I am that bread of life. Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us *his* flesh to eat? Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. As the living Father hath

sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

When "flesh and blood" is used of Jesus, it designates His whole person: "The one who eats My flesh and drinks My blood lives in Me, and I in him" (John 6:56 HCSB). The next verse shows that eating "blood and flesh" is powerful metaphorical language for sharing in the life that Jesus bestows - "so the one who feeds on Me will live because of Me" (John 6:57 HCSB).

- Luke 22:15 And he said unto them, with desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer:
- Luke 22:16 For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.
- Matthew 26:26/Mark 14:22/Luke 22:19/1 Corinthians 11:23-24 And as they were eating, That the Lord Jesus the *same* night in which he was betrayed took bread: and gave thanks, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body, which is broken for you, which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- Matthew 26:27/Mark 14:23/Luke 22:17; 20/1 Corinthians 11:25 Likewise *in* the same manner, after he had supper, also he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave *it* to them: and said, take this, and divide *it* among yourselves:
- Matthew 26:27-28/Mark 14:24/Luke 22:17/1 Corinthians 11:25 And he said unto them, for this is my blood of the new testament, this cup is the new testament in my blood: which is shed for you *and* is shed for many for the remission of sins, this do ye, as oft as ye drink *it*, in remembrance of me, Drink ye all of it;
- Matthew 26:29/Mark 14:25/Luke 22:18 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in the kingdom of God, *when* my Father's kingdom shall come.

Phil. 4:6-9 Be careful (<u>anxious</u>) for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

• Jesus is God's Gift for you

Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

• The deposit of the Holy Spirit inside of you

Eph. 1:12-14 NIV in order that we, who were the first to put our hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth,

the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession - to the praise of his glory.

• Jesus is your Comfort and will Guide you into all Truth

John 16:13-14 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew *it* unto you

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

2 Cor. 1:2-3 Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort.
