






Possession with intent to distribute

Mark Hankins has a police officer in his church that took them on Patrol the show the drug trafficking areas. When he made a drug bust, he caught two individuals with enough crack cocaine in a bottle not just for their own use but to show that they are distributors. They had been charged with possession with intent to distribute.

Therefore, I am guilty as charged because I have been caught red-handed with the intent to distribute the blood of Jesus Christ because it has been applied to every area of my life. When you have possession with the intent to distribute, you ought to say I'm guilty. I've been caught with so much faith in the blood of Jesus that I was planning on distributing. I was planning on winning souls and telling people about Jesus so that, through faith in the blood of Jesus they could be launched out of the atmosphere of sin and death into the presence of God. We were redeemed not with silver and gold, but with the precious blood of Jesus as a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:18-19).

A lot of Christians are out of position and not walking in all that the blood has purchased for them.

Eph. 2:6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

As you draw near to God, take your position in Him and receive your inheritance. Boldly declare every day, "I take my position!"

Last year at the beginning of the year, I was one county over heading home towards my exit after volunteering at a veterans' facility. I moved around a police vehicle to get off on my exit as safely as I could possible because there was a person tailing me. When I got off on the exit the police officer stopped me and charged me with the move over law. Apparently, I did not get over far enough and in this county, this is considered a felony charge. My wife consistently said I was not guilty as I considered these charges. The trial was delayed because of the pandemic safety issues. Fall 2020, I listened for seven months on **The Power of the Blood of Jesus** and began to plead the blood of Jesus over my case. When I went to trial, I showed up in a suit and my lawyers entered a plea bargain after I found out that the regular so-called Judge Judy was not on the bench. The substitute judge was a merciful judge who was handing out lower charges like candy even to drug dealers and people with gun violations. It was interesting to watch as the compassionate judge asked the lawyers who entered a plea bargain about my case. The judge basically took the advice from the lawyer's plea bargain as evidence of record. All I had to do was pay court charges and have a clean

driving record for six months. When I showed up six months later with the so-called Judge Judy, she threw the book at every case.

The Paraclete Holy Spirit Father stood with his son (me) at my trial. Where the blood flows the holy spirit goes. When the blood is truly honored the holy spirit shows up. The precious blood of Jesus Christ was spilt to bring us into unbroken fellowship with the trinity. The blood restores us so we may have freedom to worship a holy God because we are now holy because of that blood, and He stands with us and defend us.

My lawyer was the Holy Spirit the Advocate, and the so-called Judge Judy could not place any charges on me and threw the case out with charges dropped. Therefore, including any case in your life continue to honor the blood by pleading the blood of Jesus. The Holy Spirit is the greatest and wisest defense attorney who will honor the blood every time when you speak the blood aloud out of your mouth.

The fact that the blood has made reconciliation for sin and covered it and that as a result of this such a wonderful change has taken place in the heavenly realms, will avail us nothing unless we obtain a personal share in it. God has offered a perfect acquittal from all our sin and guilt. Because reconciliation has been made for sin, we can now be reconciled to Him. 'God was in Christ reconciling the world to himself, not imputing their trespasses to them.' Following this word of reconciliation is the invitation, 'Be reconciled to God' (2 Corinthians 5:19-20. Whoever *receives* this reconciliation for sin *is* reconciled to God. He knows that all his sins are forgiven. So perfect is the reconciliation and so completely has sin been blotted out that he who believes in Christ is looked upon by God as entirely righteous. The acquittal that he has received from God is so complete that there is absolutely nothing to prevent him from approaching God with the utmost freedom. For the enjoyment of this blessedness **nothing is necessary except faith in the blood**. *The blood alone has done everything* (Andrew Murray).

Exod. 25:22 And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which *are* upon the ark of the testimony, of all *things* which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.

- Same as propitiation where the blood was sprinkled or applied too big
- When you apply the Blood of Jesus by faith you have instant access to God

Heb. 10:19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

- "Faith in the blood is the meeting place" (Andrew Murray).
- You cannot have a meeting with God and not know it.
- You cannot have a meeting with God without being changed.
- You cannot have a meeting with God and have a sense of lack.

Faith is largely dependent on knowledge

Rom. 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

• "Faith is largely dependent on knowledge. If knowledge of what the blood can accomplish is not accurate, then faith expects little, and the more powerful effects of the blood are limited. Feeble ideas of its power prevent the deeper and more perfect manifestations of its effects" (Andrew Murray).

1 John 5:8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, **and the blood**: and these three agree in one.

- "As we seek to find out what the Scriptures teach about the blood, we will see the faith in the blood, even as we now understand it, can produce greater results in us that we have yet known; and in the future, a ceaseless blessing may be ours" (Andrew Murray).
- Have the revelation knowledge of what the blood of Jesus has done in all the realms in the earth, the beneath and the above.
- The term faith in the blood is synonymous with the OT term plead the blood
- Marks Mom always would 'plead the blood' over her family members

Is. 43:25 I, *even* I, *am* he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.

Is. 43:26 Put me in remembrance: **let us plead together**: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.

- Kenneth E. Hagin said, we would sing Just as I am without one plea, but thy blood was shed for me in the healing line.
- Throw yourself over on the mercy of God

The Pharisee and the Tax Collector (heathen)

Luke 18:9 And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

Moreover, because I have set my affection to the house of my God, I have of mine own proper good, of gold and silver, *which* I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house, *Even* three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses *withal:* The gold for *things* of gold, and the silver for *things* of silver, and for all manner of work *to be made* by the hands of artificers. And who *then* is willing to consecrate his service this day unto the LORD?

- In our sin state condition, we must have needed a good lawyer
- Jesus is our lawyer in heaven
- The Holy Spirit is our Lawyer in our heart
- You may say I've got these charges or accusations coming against me

Rev. 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

I plead the blood of Jesus because Jesus makes me measure up because of His blood.

There are three characteristics of the Advocate or Paraclete according to PC Nelson

- 1. The Advocate has exceptional knowledge (that means never hire attorney that's dumber than you).
- **2.** The Advocate has expertise in protocol and knowledge (He has a reputation for making losers into champions).
- 3. The advocate has persuasive speaking ability (He is an effective communicator).

Ps. 35:26 Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify *themselves* against me.

Ps. 35:27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

Ps. 35:28 And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness *and* of thy praise all the day long.

Communion:

John 6:47-58 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. I am that bread of life. Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us *his* flesh to eat? Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

When "flesh and blood" is used of Jesus, it designates His whole person: "The one who eats My flesh and drinks My blood lives in Me, and I in him" (John 6:56 HCSB). The next verse shows that eating "blood and flesh" is powerful metaphorical language for sharing in the life that Jesus bestows - "so the one who feeds on Me will live because of Me" (John 6:57 HCSB).

Luke 22:15 And he said unto them, with desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer:

Luke 22:16 For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.

Matthew 26:26/Mark 14:22/Luke 22:19/1 Corinthians 11:23-24 And as they were eating, That the Lord Jesus the *same* night in which he was betrayed took bread: and gave thanks, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body, which is broken for you, which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

Matthew 26:27/Mark 14:23/Luke 22:17; 20/1 Corinthians 11:25 Likewise *in* the same manner, after he had supper, also he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave *it* to them: and said, take this, and divide *it* among yourselves:

Matthew 26:27-28/Mark 14:24/Luke 22:17/1 Corinthians 11:25 And he said unto them, for this is my blood of the new testament, this cup is the new testament in my blood: which is shed for you *and* is shed for many for the remission of sins, this do ye, as oft as ye drink *it*, in remembrance of me, Drink ye all of it;

Matthew 26:29/Mark 14:25/Luke 22:18 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in the kingdom of God, *when* my Father's kingdom shall come.

Phil. 4:6-9 Be careful (anxious) for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

• Jesus is God's Gift for you

Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

• The deposit of the Holy Spirit inside of you

Eph. 1:12-14 NIV in order that we, who were the first to put our hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession - to the praise of his glory.

• Jesus is your Comfort and will Guide you into all Truth

John 16:13-14 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew *it* unto you

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

2 Cor. 1:2-3 Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort.
