Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God *is* with thee whithersoever thou goest.

Heb. 4:12 ESV For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Luke 24:31-35 TBBJ So I entered in to stay with them. Then I took My place at the table. I received the loaf, and blessed it and broke it, and handed it to them. Then their spiritual eyes were opened, and they recognized Me. Then I vanished from them. They said to each other, “Did not our hearts burn as He talked to us on the road, as He explained the Scriptures to us? Immediately they got up and returned to Jerusalem and found the eleven and the other followers all together. They heard them saying, “It is really true! The Lord has risen from the dead. He even appeared to Peter!” Then the two disciples told the others that I had risen from the dead and had been seen by Simon. The Bloodline of a Champion

We have a boldness because of the blood. We are valuable because he chose us. He purchased us and cleanse us with his blood. He chose to use us.

Andrew Murray said believer, I urge you, let every thought about the blood awaken you and the glorious confession, by his own blood, the Lord Jesus has sanctified me. He has taken complete possession of me for God, and I belong entirely to God. We were very common until we were chosen and used by the king of kings.

First Peter 29 through 10 says but you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people, that you should show forth the praises of him called you out of darkness into his harvest light which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy. God did not say, try to be or someday you will be he said, you are! It is important to agree with God and say, I am who God says I am. When we identify with Christ, we see ourselves in him.

In this verse, God says we are chosen, we are royal, we are priests, and we are holy. As a priest, we have a right to enter the presence of God. As a priest, we have also a responsibility to offer spiritual sacrifices. As a priest, we have the power to pick your blessings on others. Because of the new covenant, God calls believers a royal priesthood!

God is not only cleansed, separated, chosen, and blessed us, but he also wants to fill us with his glory. He says in exodus 29:43, the Tabernacle shall be filled with by my glory. Every hindrance has been removed so God can dwell on us. We now carry his glory. We are chosen vessels to live in his presence and to carry his glory. We cannot produce any of this. Jesus produced it for us and does the work in us. However, we will not be forced to participate, we have a choice.

See the invisible, choose the imperishable, do the impossible

By faith Moses, when he was come two years, refused to be called the son of the pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to suffer the afflictions with the people of God, rather to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season, is esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward. By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who was invisible. Through faith he kept the Passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the first born shouldn't touch them. By faith they pass through the Red Sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians are saying to do word round. Hebrews 11:24-29.

You can clearly see Moses made his choice by faith. By faith he chose, by faith he forsook Egypt, by faith he could see him who was invisible, and by faith he applied the blood. Moses was a man of faith. He was a chosen vessel for honor.

We must surrender ourselves to the will of God to be a vessel of honor. We have a choice of what kind of vessel we will be. If we want to be chosen by God for special occasions, we must participate in the sanctification process. God starts and finishes it but not without our will.

We are sanctified spirit, soul, and body (1 Thess. 5:23).

Sometimes we suffer and feel alone in the separation process. I guess it would not have been so bad to be separate if you were in the harlot rehab's house when the walls of Jericho fell down. Her house was separate, protected, and still standing by a scarlet thread hanging out of the window, Joshua six. The red thread of the blood of Jesus sanctifies us. We are chosen by God to be used by him through faith in his blood.¹

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

- **How can you pray for your pastor like Paul?**

Door of Utterance - Pray for Paul that utterance may come to him.

- **Paul was not lacking in revelation (Holy Information).**

20th CNT = that Words may given to me.

- **It is supernatural utterance from the Holy Ghost**
- **The devil is scared of those with utterance**
- **the individual believer can move mountains**
- **When a man or woman from their office of utterance they can affect a whole nation**
- **Those in that office operate with their mouth and their mouth is registered in hell**
- **NEB Bible says they're granted the right words to say**
- **Beck translation says they are told what to say**
- **Acts 10:44 when Peter spoke those words the Holy Ghost fell**

Acts 10:44 While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word.

- **The very scenery changes by the words of your mouth**
- **Every attack is to stop your mouth**
- **The apostle Paul singing in Acts 16, didn't stop their mouths. And everybody walked out of the jail**

Acts 16:25-26 And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.

- **Say what God's will is for your life**
- **my mouth will set many free**
- **Isaiah 49:2 God made my mouth a weapon**

Is. 49:2 And he hath made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand hath he hid me, and made me a polished shaft; in his quiver hath he hid me.

- **With preaching and teaching, make room for the Holy Ghost. You will be told what to say.**
- **Prophetic preaching by Charles Finney, for 12 years he wrote not a word only what he heard in prayer for his preaching**
- **Preaching success and the power by the Holy Ghost**
- **everything happens by speaking**
- **mountains are made out of words.**
- **If it has not been spoken, it will not happen**
- **one big mouth can change a city or a nation**
- **He set in the body of Christ preachers and teachers**
- **Lord touch my mouth with prophetic prayer.**
- **There is another dimension when utterance is given to you**
- **We preach the gospel with the Holy Ghost (I Pet. 1:12).**

1 Pet. 1:12 Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

- **This type of preaching activates angels**

The Door of Utterance

Col. 4:3-4 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds: That I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak.

- **Pray – the Preacher needs prayer**
- **The Word of the Lord may have free course and be glorified**

2 Thess. 3:1 Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have *free* course, and be glorified, even as *it is* with you:

Moffit = Word of the Lord may speed on.

Barclay = May goeth forth unhindered.

Phillips = with power.

The Call of Jeremiah

Jer. 1:4 Then the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

Jer. 1:5 Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, *and* I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

Jer. 1:6 Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, I cannot speak: for I *am* a child.

Jer. 1:7 But the LORD said unto me, Say not, I *am* a child: for thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak.

Jer. 1:8 Be not afraid of their faces: for I *am* with thee to deliver thee, saith the LORD.

Jer. 1:9 Then the LORD put forth his hand, and touched my mouth. And the LORD said unto me, Behold, I have put my words in thy mouth.

Jer. 1:10 See, I have this day set thee over the nations and over the kingdoms, to root out, and to pull down, and to destroy, and to throw down, to build, and to plant.

Jer. 1:11 Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Jeremiah, what seest thou? And I said, I see a rod of an almond tree.

Jer. 1:12 Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it.

- **Jesus is the Way**

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.**

- **Jesus is the go-between**

1 Tim. 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

- **Jesus is God's Gift for you**

Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

- **Jesus has Redeemed with His blood**

Eph. 1:7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

1 Pet. 1:18-19 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

- **Your active part – align your heart with your mouth**

Rom. 10:9-10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

- **Jesus is interceding for us**

Rom. 8:34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

Rev. 12:11 (ISV) Our brothers conquered him by the blood of the lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they did not cling to their lives even in the face of death.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

- **Come Home**

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

- **God has already demonstrated His love toward us**

Rom. 5:8 ISV But God demonstrates his love for us by the fact that the Messiah died for us while we were still sinners.

- **Jesus emptied Himself for you**

Phil. 2:7-8 ESV but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

- **Jesus became was the perfect sacrifice to restore your fellowship with God**

Is. 53:4-5 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

- **Jesus is interceding for us**

Rom. 8:34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

- **Jesus is the resurrection, and the life**

John 11:25-26 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

- **Jesus is your Comfort and will Guide you into all Truth**

John 16:13-14 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

2 Cor. 1:2-3 Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort.
