- **Returning the tithe to God helps us remember that He is the owner of everything.**

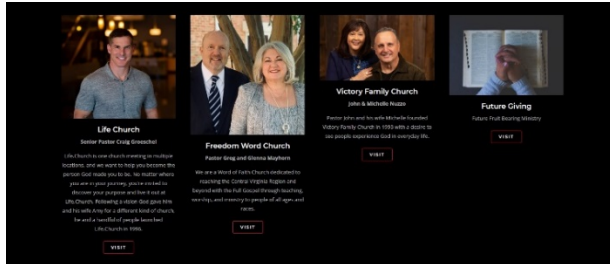
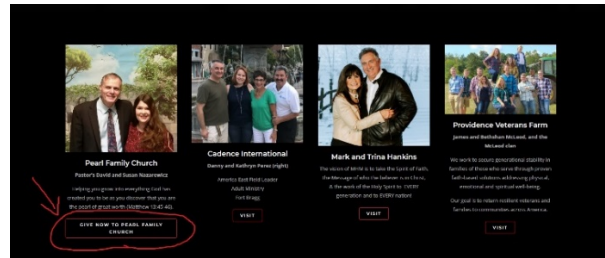

Possession with intent to distribute

Mark Hankins has a police officer in his church that took them on Patrol the show the drug trafficking areas. When he made a drug bust, he caught two individuals with enough crack cocaine in a bottle not just for their own use but to show that they are distributors. They had been charged with possession with intent to distribute.

Therefore, I am guilty as charged because I have been caught red-handed with the intent to distribute the blood of Jesus Christ because it has been applied to every area of my life. When you have possession with the intent to distribute, you ought to say I'm guilty. I've been caught with so much faith in the blood of Jesus that I was planning on distributing. I was planning on winning souls and telling people about Jesus so that, through faith in the blood of Jesus they could be launched out of the atmosphere of sin and death into the presence of God. We were redeemed not with silver and gold, but with the precious blood of Jesus as a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:18-19).

A lot of Christians are out of position and not walking in all that the blood has purchased for them.

Eph. 2:6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

As you draw near to God, take your position in Him and receive your inheritance. Boldly declare every day, "I take my position!"

Gal. 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me

My Story

When my wife and I moved to Virginia, we found a townhouse that we moved into that we both had a peace about. We didn't really know the history of the area or the history of the property. However, we would travel back and forth to North Carolina to visit my wife's dad because he was put on dialysis.

One return trip home we found out our home flooded. I almost gave up on the situation because we both had worked so hard and didn't have it in us to really deal with mess and damage.

However, ever since I found my true case in the blood of Jesus Christ, every time there is a hint of a down pour, I plead the blood of Jesus over our household and others and pray for the waters to pass by. There was only one time I was too busy that did not plead the blood over my household and the water came in. The blood of Jesus is alive and eternal. Step into the reality of His sacrifice that can absolutely put into remission or fruition your requests unto God.

Heb. 9:19-21 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people, Saying, This *is* the blood of the testament which God hath enjoined unto you. Moreover he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle, and all the vessels of the ministry.

Col. 1:12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

- **Meet = He has qualified us, or He has made us worthy**

Col. 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son:

Col. 1:14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

The Preeminence of Christ

Col. 1:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:

Col. 1:16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

Col. 1:17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

Col. 1:18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all *things* he might have the preeminence.

Col. 1:19 For it pleased *the Father* that in him should all fulness dwell;

- **If you are not in Christ – You have not seen Him lately**
- **Redeemed = He purchased our freedom from something and to something**

Col. 1:20-22 TLB It was through what his Son did that God cleared a path for everything to come to him - all things in heaven and on earth - for Christ's death on the cross has made peace with God for all by his blood. This includes you who were once so far away from God. You were his enemies and hated him and were separated from him by your evil thoughts and actions, yet now he has brought you back as his friends. He has done this through the death on the cross of his own human body, and now as a result Christ has brought you into the very presence of God, and you are standing there before him with nothing left against you - **nothing left that he could even chide you for.**

Gal. 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that hangeth on a tree:

- **In the OT the priest examined the sacrifice**
- **The bases of your cleansing were based on the sacrifice**
- **Jesus was the Perfect sacrifice that God says He accepted**

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

- **We are now Jesus' blood conscience**

Heb. 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

Heb. 10:15 *Whereof* the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,

Heb. 10:16 This *is* the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

Definition of plead – “the mutual altercations between the plaintiff and the defendant or written statements of the parties in support of their claims, comprehending the declaration, count, or narration of the plaintiff, the plea of the defendant in reply, the replication of the plaintiff to defendant's plea, the defenders rejoinder, the plaintiff's sur-rejoinder, the defendants rebuttal, the plaintiffs sur-rebuttal, etc. **until the question is brought to issue, that is to rest on a single point.**”

Rev. 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Sin has gone into remission

Heb. 10:18 Now where **remission** of these *is, there is* no more offering for sin.

There is no penalty for excessive celebration

The Full Assurance of Faith

Heb. 10:19 Having therefore, brethren, **boldness** to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

- **You have the access code into the throne room by the blood of Jesus for Him to download information that you need**

Heb. 10:20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

Heb. 10:21 And *having* an high priest over the house of God;

Heb. 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Heb. 12:22 But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,

- **Jesus is the go-between**

1 Tim. 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

- **Your active part – align your heart with your mouth**

Rom. 10:9-10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.**

- **Made righteous**

2 Cor. 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Revelation – if over 80% of the world is not blood conscience – counting the blood of Jesus Holy and precious...

1 Thess. 5:16-23 Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. Abstain from all appearance of evil. And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Heb. 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

- **Jesus is God's Gift for you**

Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

- **Your active part – align your heart with your mouth**

Rom. 10:9-10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Communion:

John 6:47-58 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. I am that bread of life. Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us *his* flesh to eat? Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

When “flesh and blood” is used of Jesus, it designates His whole person: “The one who eats My flesh and drinks My blood lives in Me, and I in him” (John 6:56 HCSB). The next verse shows that eating “blood and flesh” is powerful metaphorical language for sharing in the life that Jesus bestows - “so the one who feeds on Me will live because of Me” (John 6:57 HCSB).

Luke 22:15 And he said unto them, **with desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer:**

Luke 22:16 For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.

Matthew 26:26/Mark 14:22/Luke 22:19/1 Corinthians 11:23-24 And as they were eating, That the Lord Jesus the *same* night in which he was betrayed took bread: and gave thanks, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, **Take, eat; this is my body, which is broken for you, which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.**

Matthew 26:27/Mark 14:23/Luke 22:17; 20/1 Corinthians 11:25 Likewise *in* the same manner, after he had supper, also he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave *it* to them: and said, **take this, and divide it among yourselves:**

Matthew 26:27-28/Mark 14:24/Luke 22:17/1 Corinthians 11:25 And he said unto them, **for this is my blood of the new testament, this cup is the new testament in my blood: which is shed for you and is shed for many for the remission of sins, this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me, Drink ye all of it;**

Matthew 26:29/Mark 14:25/Luke 22:18 Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in the kingdom of God, *when my Father's kingdom shall come.*

Phil. 4:6-9 Be careful (anxious) for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

- **Jesus is God's Gift for you**

Eph. 2:8-9 for by grace have ye been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not of works, that no man should glory.

- **The deposit of the Holy Spirit inside of you**

Eph. 1:12-14 NIV in order that we, who were the first to put our hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession - to the praise of his glory.

- **Jesus is your Comfort and will Guide you into all Truth**

John 16:13-14 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you*
